



Maudsley and Bethlem Case Study

Situation

Maudsley & Bethlem Hospital School (MBHS) is a local authority special school based in London, England. Dr. John Ivens (Executive Headteacher), Maarten Crommelin (Headteacher) and their team provide educational support for children and young people aged 4 to 18 who are patients of the Maudsley & Bethlem Hospitals. The school also provides personalised learning and support for pupils who have psychological illnesses that affect their learning and their ability to function appropriately and successfully in the community.

MBHS identified an opportunity to refurbish the school's gymnasium, and owing to the allocated budget were required to not only follow their own internal governance, but also advertise the contract opportunity in line the Public Contract Regulations (2015). MBHS reached out to Daniel Gibson, our Procurement Director, requesting end-to-end management of the procurement process to ensure that all internal procedures and requirements would be met.

Task

Working closely with the school's senior leadership team and the asset management teams at Maudsley & Bethlem Hospitals, Hudson Procure developed an appropriate procurement project strategy, built a full suite of tender documents, and fully managed the tender process including electronic hosting of the project.

Action

The process sought out specialist contractors who were encouraged to submit bids on a design & build basis, with the tender ensuring that the skills and experience of bidders were fully harnessed to arrive at the best solution for the school.

Result

Through transparent communications with MBHS's senior leadership team, Dan managed to help MBHS to appoint a forward thinking, proactive contractor with demonstrable project management skills that were on course to deliver on-time and on-budget.
